Westchester Man Arrested For His 5th DUI Arrest

On November 13, 2009, the Bartlett Police Department arrested Ruben Ortiz, 62, of 2335 Boager Avenue, Westchester. The DuPage County State's Attorney's Office and Police charged him with a Class 2 Felony for Aggravated Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, a Class 4 Felony for Aggravated Driving With a Revoked License, a Class A Misdemeanor for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, and a Class A Misdemeanor for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol With a BAC of .08 or more. He was also cited for Improper Lane Usage and Illegal Transportation/Possession of Alcoholic Liquor. This was Ortiz' 5th arrest for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol since 1984.

At approximately 10:30 pm, Police stopped a green colored 1996 Chevrolet 3500 at the intersection of South Bartlett Road and Orchards Pass for improper lane usage. During the traffic stop, Police alleged the driver, Ortiz, had an open container of an alcoholic beverage in his vehicle. Police also learned Ortiz' driver's license was revoked. He was subsequently arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Driving With a Revoked License.

On November 14, 2009, Ortiz was transported to the DuPage County Jail in Wheaton to await his bail bond hearing.
