15-Year-Old Accused of Breaking into the Aquatic Center Concession Stand

On August 22, 2009, the Bartlett Police Department arrested a 15-year-old female juvenile with a Class A Misdemeanor offense of Criminal Damage to Property and a Class A Misdemeanor offense of Theft.

At approximately 8:15 am, the Bartlett Police Department responded to the Bartlett Aquatic Center located at 620 W. Stearns Road to investigate a report that a 15-year-old female juvenile stole candy and potato chips from the concession stand. Police alleged she threw a large decorative rock through the countertop window in order to gain access to the food snacks that were displayed inside the concession stand. Police were able to locate the 15-year-old female juvenile and take her into custody after she fled the scene on foot. The 15-year-old female juvenile was later released to her mother after she was petitioned to DuPage County Juvenile Court.

The Bartlett Police Department would like to commend a few individuals at the Bartlett Skate Park for their valued assistance with the successful apprehension of the 15-year-old female juvenile immediately after the incident occurred.
