Bartlett Police Department to increase Speed Enforcement during August

During the month of August the Bartlett Police Department will be increasing the number of patrol officers assigned to enforce speed laws. The police department will have additional officers enforcing speed laws in areas of the village where there are high incidents of traffic crashes. The areas the police department will be focusing on will be Stearns Rd. between S. Bartlett Rd. and Illinois Route 59; Lake St. between Naperville Rd. and N. Bartlett Rd., Illinois Route 59 between Army Trail Road and Lake St., and Schick Rd.

The Bartlett Police Department will be increasing patrol efforts in compliance with a grant they received. **The Speed Enforcement Program, (SEP) grant**, from the Illinois Department of Transportation has a goal of reducing the incidence of speeding related motor vehicle crashes, and the resulting injuries and fatalities, through highly visible increased enforcement of speed related laws.
