Former Chanterelles Accountant Found Guilty of Violating Her Probation

On October 7, 2009, Lynda Bolin, 38, of 1139 Apple Hill Court, Elgin was found guilty of violating her probation by committing a Theft Over \$100,000 while managing finances for Chanterelles Restaurant, formerly located at 110 W. Bartlett Avenue. Chanterelles Restaurant opened for business during August 2002 as a steak and seafood restaurant in downtown Bartlett. Bolin was accused of embezzling more than \$250,000 while working as the accountant for the business after the Bartlett Police Department and the Cook County State's Attorney's Office Financial Crimes Unit completed a two-year investigation. Bolin was on felony probation for a previous Theft Over \$100,000 offense when the alleged offense in Bartlett occurred. Bolin's sentencing is scheduled for December 3, 2009 at 1:00 pm at the Cook County Criminal Court Facility located at 2650 S. California in Chicago, Illinois.
