Bartlett Man Arrested Again for Unlawfully Permitting a Minor to Become Intoxicated

On December 4, 2009 the Bartlett Police Department arrested John J. Engler, 23, of 811 S. Sheridan Drive, Bartlett. He was charged with a Class A Misdemeanor for Unlawfully Permitted a Minor to Become Intoxicated. Police also arrested Christos J. Peroulas, 18, 7109 99th Street, Chicago Ridge. He was charged with a Class A Misdemeanor for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor and cited for a Loud Muffler. Police also cited Dennis N. Gantchv, 17, of 4534 N. Cumberland Avenue, Chicago for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor.

At approximately 3:20 am, Bartlett Police conducted a traffic stop on a red colored 1997 Mitsubishi Eclipse on Newport Boulevard and Valleyview Drive for a loud muffler. Police suspected the driver, Peroulas, and the front seat passenger, Gantchv, consumed an alcoholic beverage. Police also learned Gantchv consumed an alcoholic beverage at Engler's residence located at 811 S. Sheridan Drive. Police subsequently arrested Peroulas for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor and cited Gantchv for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor. Police then proceeded to 811 S. Sheridan Drive and arrested Engler for Unlawfully Permitting a Minor to Become Intoxicated following an investigation. This was Engler's second arrest for the same offense since November 27, 2009.

Engler and Peroulas were both released on bond with a future court date to be assigned by the DuPage County Circuit Court Clerk. Gantchv was released on his signature with a court date of December 22, 2009 at the Cook County court facility located in Rolling Meadows.
