Bartlett Resident Charged with Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor and Assault

On October 31, 2009, the Bartlett Police Department arrested Marie D. Latorre, 44, of 511 Hampton Circle, Bartlett. She was charged with a Class A Misdemeanor for Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor and a Class C Misdemeanor for Assault. Police also cited a 16-year-old female juvenile for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor and a 16-year-old male juvenile & a 14-year-old female juvenile for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor and Curfew Violation.

At approximately 11:30 am, Police responded to 511 Hampton Circle to investigate a report of an alleged loud underage drinking party. During this time, Police were approached by a female resident, who alleged she was assaulted by Latorre when she went to the residence to pickup her teenager. Police alleged her teenager consumed alcoholic beverages while attending a party at 511 Hampton Circle. During the investigation, Police located a suspicious black colored 2007 GMC vehicle that was parked on Camdon Circle and Amherst Drive. Police alleged the male and female juvenile occupants consumed alcoholic beverages while attending a party at 511 Hampton Circle.

Latorre was released on a \$1,000 recognizance bond with a court date of November 17, 2009 at 9:00 am at the DuPage County court facility located in Wheaton. A 16-year-old female juvenile was issued a court date of November 17, 2009 at 1:30 pm at the Cook County court facility in Rolling Meadows. A 16-year-old male and a 14-year-old female were issued a court date of December 22, 2009 at 10:30 am at the Cook County court facility in Rolling Meadows.
