Driver Charged After Almost Striking a Police Officer with his Vehicle

On June 12, 2009, the Bartlett Police Department arrested Patrick M. Ebbesen, 19, of the 1600 block of Penny Lane in Bartlett, Illinois. He was charged with six Class A Misdemeanor offenses of Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Unlawful Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor, Fleeing or Attempting to Elude a Police Officer, Aggravated Assault, and Domestic Battery.

At approximately 1:00 am, Bartlett Police investigated a disturbance in the parking lot of a liquor establishment in the 300 block of S. Prospect Avenue. During this time, Police attempted to stop a 2004 Pontiac Grand Am driven by Ebbesen when he allegedly almost struck a police officer with his vehicle before exiting the parking lot area southbound on Prospect Avenue. Police immediately located Ebbesen's vehicle on Newport Boulevard and Devon Avenue, where it was alleged that he was involved in a physical altercation with a 21-year-old female in the parking lot area of the liquor establishment. During the investigation, Police discovered items of drug paraphernalia inside Ebbesen's vehicle.

Ebbesen was released on bond and was issued a court date of July 16, 2009 at 9:00 am at the Cook County court facility located in Rolling Meadows for the Aggravated Assault, Domestic Battery, and Fleeing or Attempting to Elude a Police Officer offenses. Ebbesen was also issued a court date of June 30, 2009 at 9:00 am at the DuPage County Judicial Center in Wheaton for the Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Unlawful Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor offenses.
