Four Vehicle Crash Shuts Down Northbound Lanes of IL Route 59

On December 8, 2009 at approximately 7:30 am, the Bartlett Police Department responded to the area of IL Route 59 and Santa Fe Street to investigate a motor vehicle crash involving four vehicles. Police alleged a 49-year-old Bartlett woman was driving her green colored 2000 Ford Expedition southbound on IL Route 59 when she lost control of her vehicle due to the inclement weather. Her vehicle spun out of control into the northbound lanes of IL Route 59 causing a 1998 Honda Accord, a 2004 GMC Savana, and a 1995 Lincoln Mark VIII to crash.

The driver of the Accord suffered minor injuries and was transported to Central DuPage Hospital by the Bartlett Fire Protection District. The northbound lanes of IL Route 59 were shut down for approximately 45 minutes while the Expedition, Accord, and Savana were towed from the scene and the Mark VIII was pulled out of a ditch on the eastside of the roadway.

No charges have been filed at this time and Bartlett Police continue to investigate the motor vehicle crash.
