Police Shut Down Lake Street Due to Accident

On August 6, 2009 at approximately 11:45 am, the Bartlett Police Department responded to the intersection of Lake Street/U.S. Route 20 and Club Tree Drive for a motor vehicle crash involving a vehicle that rolled over several times before landing upside down. Police discovered Lauren D. Figueroa, 26, of Streamwood was attempting to turn left onto the northbound lanes of Club Tree Drive from eastbound Lake Street/U.S. Route 20 when the passenger side door was struck by a silver colored 2000 Chevrolet Impala driven by Michael J. Anaya, 33, of Streamwood, who was traveling westbound on Lake Street/U.S. Route 20.

Figueroa suffered minor injuries from the motor vehicle crash and was transported to St. Alexius Hospital in Hoffman Estates by the Bartlett Fire Protection District. Anaya and his two passengers were treated and released at the scene by the Bartlett Fire Protection District. The westbound lanes of Lake Street/U.S. Route 20 at Park Boulevard were temporarily shut down for approximately 15 minutes. Police did not suspect the accident was caused by a distraction inside the vehicle, alcohol, or drugs.

Figueroa will be issued a traffic citation for Failure to Yield Turning Left after she is released from the hospital.
