Bartlett Police Investigate Serious Crash on Lake Street

On July 24, 2009 at approximately 8:10 am, the Bartlett Police Department responded to Lake Street near Old Lake Street for a serious motor vehicle crash involving two vehicles. Police alleged Christopher J. Musatto of Elgin was driving a black colored 1971 Ford Mustang eastbound on Lake Street when his vehicle crossed over into the westbound lanes of traffic and was struck by a white colored Ford F-150 driven by Lisa M. Helgerson of South Elgin. The impact of the collision caused Musatto's vehicle to go down an embankment on the north side of the roadway. Musatto suffered serious injuries and was transported by the Bartlett Fire Protection District to St. Alexius Medical Center in Hoffman Estates.

The eastbound and westbound lanes of Lake Street were closed between North Bartlett Road and IL Route 59 for approximately 1 ½ hours. The Bartlett Police Department's Traffic Crash Investigators continue to investigate the cause of the motor vehicle crash.
