Bartlett Police Department Celebrates Promotions

On Friday, June 26, 2009, the Bartlett Police Department celebrated the promotions of Commander Patrick Ullrich, Sergeant Michael McGuigan, and Officer Michael Rummell in the Village Hall Council Chambers. Patrick Ullrich was appointed to the rank of Deputy Chief, Michael McGuigan was appointed to the rank of Commander, and Michael Rummell was promoted to the rank of Sergeant.

Deputy Chief Ullrich has been with the Bartlett Police Department for eleven years. He served as a Crime Prevention Officer, Juvenile Officer, D.A.R.E Instructor, Truck Enforcement Officer, Breathalyzer Operator, and an Emergency Vehicle Operator's Course instructor. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Law Enforcement & Justice Administration from Western Illinois University and graduated from the Northwestern University Center for Public Safety School of Police & Command. In 2004, he was promoted to the rank of Sergeant and then was appointed to the rank of Commander in 2006. Deputy Chief Ullrich will assume the command of the Administrative Division in charge of the Records Section, Property Control, Planning & Research, Fleet Maintenance, and Emergency Management.

Commander McGuigan has been with the Bartlett Police Department for thirteen years. He served as a Breathalyzer Operator, Tactical Medical Officer, S.P.E.A.R Team member, and a CPR/AED Instructor. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Administration of Justice from Southern Illinois University and graduated from the Northwestern University Center for Public Safety School of Police & Command. In 2003, he was promoted to the rank of Sergeant and served as the supervisor for the Public Services Bureau and Honor Guard. He also received two Life Saving Awards during August of 1998 and August of 2002. Commander McGuigan will be assigned to the Patrol Section as one of the two Patrol Commanders.

Sergeant Rummell has been with the Bartlett Police Department for twelve years. He served as an Eastview Middle School Resource Officer, Field Training Officer, Juvenile Officer, Defensive Tactics Instructor, S.P.E.A.R Team member, NIPAS Emergency Services Team member, and Evidence Technician. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Sociology from Eastern Illinois University. Sergeant Rummell will be assigned to the Patrol Section as a Shift Supervisor.
