Two Separate Driving Incidents Result in Underage Drinking Charges

On September 5, 2009, the Bartlett Police Department cited Elizabeth D. Toy, 18, of 560 Chesterfield Lane, South Elgin for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor and Disobeying a Traffic Control Device. Toy's passenger, Kaitlyn R. Sears, 18, of 42W304 Retreat Court, St Charles was also cited for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor. On September 6, 2009, the Bartlett Police Department cited Renata Rodriguez, 19, of 1833 Williamsburg Drive, Hoffman Estates for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor and Improper Lane Usage. Rodriguez's passenger, Ciara Zamora, 19, of 955 Charlela Lane #309, Elk Grove Village was also cited for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor.

On September 5, 2009 at approximately 4:00 am, the Bartlett Police Department investigated a single-vehicle accident on West Bartlett Road and the Canadian National railroad crossing. Police determined Toy was driving a silver colored 1998 Honda Civic westbound on West Bartlett when she disregarded the street closure sign and then struck the railroad tracks. Police alleged Toy and Sears consumed alcoholic beverages while being under 21 years old.

On September 6, 2009 at approximately 3:00 am, the Bartlett Police Department conducted a traffic stop on a white colored 2003 Mitsubishi Galant at the intersection of U.S. Route 20/Lake Street and Oak Avenue for Improper Lane Usage. During the traffic encounter, Police alleged Rodriguez and Zamora consumed alcoholic beverages while being under 21 years old.

Toy and Sears were both released on their signatures and were issued a court date of September 24, 2009 at the Cook County court facility located in Rolling Meadows. Rodriguez and Zamora were also both released on their signatures and were issued a court date of October 14, 2009 at the Cook County court facility in Rolling Meadows.
