Two Separate Incidents Result in Underage Drinking Charges

On August 17, 2009, the Bartlett Police Department charged Daniel W. Powell, 19, of 810 Red Oak Drive, Bartlett with Class A Misdemeanor counts of Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor and Domestic Battery. Police also cited Alexis M. Fusz, 17, of 226 Shawnee Circle, Bartlett for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor. On August 18, 2009, police cited Ian R. St. John, 18, of 134 N. Elroy Avenue, Bartlett and a 16-year-old male juvenile for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor.

On August 17, 2009 at approximately 3:40 pm, the Bartlett Police Department investigated a suspicious situation at the 700 block of South Bartlett Road. Following an investigation, Police alleged Powell and Fusz consumed alcoholic beverages while being under 21 years old. Police also arrested Powell for Domestic Battery after allegedly grabbing a female victim.

On August 18, 2009 at approximately 1:00 am, the Bartlett Police Department conducted an extra patrol at a business in the 1500 block of IL Route 59. Police observed what appeared to be several juveniles smoking and loitering in the parking lot area. Following an investigation, Police alleged St. John and a 16-year-old male juvenile consumed alcoholic beverages while being under 21 years old. Police previously cited St. John for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor after investigating a suspicious vehicle on August 7, 2009 at approximately 1:50 am.

Powell was transported to the DuPage County Jail in Wheaton to await his bail bond hearing. Fusz, St. John, and the 16-year-old male juvenile were issued a court date of September 10, 2009 at the Cook County court facility located in Rolling Meadows.
