Bartlett Police Investigate Underage Drinking Party

On November 27, 2009 the Bartlett Police Department arrested John J. Engler, 23, of 811 S. Sheridan Drive and Mantas Vasiljevas, 19, of 125 67th Street, Darien. Police charged Engler with a Class A Misdemeanor for Unlawfully Permitting a Minor to Become Intoxicated and Vasiljevas with a Class A Misdemeanor for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor. Police also cited Tadas Einikis, 20, of 4616 W. 96th Place, Oak Lawn for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor.

At approximately 1:30 am, Police responded to a residence located at 811 S. Sheridan Drive to investigate an alleged underage drinking party. Police observed Vasiljevas walk from the rear of the residence and then attempt to hide between several vehicles parked on the driveway. During the investigation, Police spoke to the homeowner, Engler, and Einikis, who just exited the residence. Police determined Vasiljevas and Einikis consumed alcoholic beverages inside Engler's residence. Police subsequently arrested Engler for Unlawfully Permitting a Minor to Become Intoxicated and Vasiljevas for Unlawful Consumption of Alcoholic Liquor.

Engler and Vasiljevas were both released on a recognizance bond and issued a court date of December 29, 2009 at the DuPage County court facility located in Wheaton. Einikis was released on his signature and issued a court date of January 8, 2010 at the Cook County court facility located in Rolling Meadows.
