Hanover Park & Roselle Residents Charged with Breaking into Vehicles

On August 6, 2009, the Bartlett Police Department arrested Jeffrey D. Walker, 18, of 6364 Freemont Drive, Hanover Park and David R. Hudson, 18, of 785 E. Irving Park Road, Roselle. The Cook County State's Attorney's Office and the Bartlett Police Department charged them with two Class 2 counts of Burglary.

At approximately 1:30 am, the Bartlett Police Department investigated a suspicious unoccupied red colored 1993 Lincoln vehicle parked in front of Firefighter's Park located near the 570 block of Ford lane. Police discovered Walker walking in the neighborhood on Lela Lane. Following an investigation, Police alleged Walker and Hudson stole several electronic and personal items from several unlocked vehicles parked on Baytree Drive.

Walker and Hudson were issued a \$20,000 Recognizance Bond at the Cook County court facility in Rolling Meadows with a court date of August 28, 2009 at 1:30 pm.
