Bartlett Woman Arrested for Prostitution and Drug Offenses

On October 30, 2009, the Bartlett Police Department arrested Sherry A. Rutz, 30, of 102 N Elroy Avenue, Bartlett. She was charged with a Class 4 Felony for Prostitution Within 1,000 feet of Real Property Comprising a School, a Class 1 Felony for Unlawful Possession of a Controlled Substance, and a Class A Misdemeanor for Unlawful Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

At approximately 10:20 AM, Police alleged Rutz invited an undercover police officer into her residence to engage in sexual activity for money. Police started to investigate Rutz on September 4, 2009 after discovering her profile "Mercedes" on a local adult escort and adult website. Following an investigation, Police seized less than 30 grams of cocaine and drug paraphernalia from Rutz' residence.

On October 31, 2009, Rutz was transported to the Cook County Jail located in Rolling Meadows to await her bail bond hearing. She was later released on a \$5,000 personal recognizance bond with a court date of November 25, 2009 at 9:00 am at the Cook County court facility in Rolling Meadows.
