Bartlett Man Arrested For Aggravated Assault & Resisting a Peace Officer

On June 8, 2009, the Bartlett Police Department arrested Brian W. Matousek, 30, of the 200 block of Lamont Parkway in Bartlett, Illinois. He was charged with two Class A Misdemeanor offenses of Aggravated Assault and Resisting a Peace Officer.

At approximately 7:30 pm, Bartlett Police responded to the 200 block of South Oak Avenue for a report of a despondent subject. Police found Matousek sitting in the passenger seat of a Jeep Cherokee parked on the roadway. Police suspected Matousek was possibly armed with a weapon. Police attempted to take him into custody after he allegedly made a furtive movement inside the vehicle. Police alleged Matousek physically resisted the police officers at the scene after he was arrested.

Matousek was released on bond and was issued a court date of July 16, 2009 at 9:00 am at the Cook County court facility located in Rolling Meadows.
