Bartlett Police Charge Two South Elgin Residents With Burglary

On July 5, 2009, the Bartlett Police Department arrested Phokeo S. Luangrath, 17, of 1361 Burke Lane, South Elgin, Illinois and Matthew R. Mills, 17, of 701 A. Fieldcrest Drive, South Elgin, Illinois. The Cook County State's Attorney's Office and the Bartlett Police Department charged both of them with two Class 2 Felony counts of Burglary From a Motor Vehicle.

At approximately 11:00 pm, the Bartlett Police Department responded to the area of the S. Prospect Avenue and Oneida Avenue a report of individuals looking into and attempting to open unlocked parked vehicles. Police located Mills and Luangrath walking in the vicinity of North Avenue and Crest Avenue. Following an investigation, they were taken into custody after Police recovered several items of electronic equipment that were stolen from unlocked parked vehicles in the 110 block of Marion Avenue and the 190 block of Elizabeth Court.

Luangrath and Mills were transported to the Cook County court facility located in Rolling Meadows, Illinois for their bail bond hearing.
