2 Teens and Prospect Heights Man Face Trespassing Charges

On July 7, 2009, the Bartlett Police Department arrested Ryszard S. Mirek, 20, of 880 E. Willow Road Apt. 188, Prospect Heights, Illinois and two 15-year-old male juveniles. The Bartlett Police Department charged Mirek with two Class A Misdemeanor offenses of Criminal Trespass to Real Property & Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor. The 15-year-old male juveniles were charged with the Class A Misdemeanor offense of Criminal Trespass to Real Property.

At approximately 3:00 am, the Bartlett Police Department responded to a residence in the 700 block of Bayberry Drive for a report of a suspicious person ringing the doorbell. Police located a 15-year-old male juvenile running eastbound on Bayberry Drive and Mirek hiding nearby. Another 15-year-old male juvenile was later located at his residence. Police allege the two 15-year-old male juveniles and Mirek attempted to enter the residence, but were unsuccessful because they were disrupted by the homeowner.

Mirek was released on a \$1,000 recognizance bond. He was given a court date of August 14, 2009 at 9:00 am at the Cook County court facility in Rolling Meadows, Illinois. The two 15-year-old male juveniles were petitioned to Cook County Juvenile Court and later released to their parents.
