Two Men Arrested After Police Investigate DUI Crash

On February 4, 2010 the Bartlett Police Department arrested Brandon P. Rodriguez, 21, of 1500 Spruce Avenue, Hanover Park and Christopher M. Suderski, 23, of 2222 Brent Court, Schaumburg. Rodriguez was charged with two Class A Misdemeanors for Battery and Resisting a Peace Officer and Suderski was charged with a Class A Misdemeanor for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and cited for Failure to Reduce Speed to Avoid an Accident.

At approximately 2:40 am, Bartlett Police responded to the intersection of US Route 20/Lake Street and North Bartlett Road to investigate a motor vehicle crash involving two vehicles. Police determined Suderski was driving a blue colored 2004 Chrysler PT Cruiser eastbound on US Route 20/Lake Street when he rear-ended a 2004 Hyundai sports utility vehicle that was stopped at the red light. Police alleged Rodriguez, who was a passenger of the Hyundai vehicle approached Suderski and then punched him several times in the facial and chest areas before two commercial vehicle drivers came to his aid. Following an investigation, Suderski was arrested for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol and Rodriguez was arrested for Battery. Rodriguez was also accused of resisting the arrest when police attempted to take him into custody. Suderski suffered injuries from the alleged battery and was transported to St. Alexius Medical Center in Hoffman Estates by the Bartlett Fire Protection District.

Rodriguez and Suderski were both released on a \$1,000 recognizance bond. They were assigned a court date of March 23, 2010 at the Cook County court facility located in Rolling Meadows.
