Six Students Cited For Senior Prank

On May 21, 2010 Bartlett Police Department cited three 17-year-old male juveniles; Stephen C. Maggard, 18, of 1346 Keenland Drive, Bartlett; Kyle M. Davis, 18, of 1315 Branden Lane, Bartlett; and Zachary C. Konstanzer, 18, of 2289 Waterfall Lane, Hanover Park; for Dangerous Acts Prohibited.

At approximately 7:15 am, Bartlett Police Department investigated an alleged senior prank where baby oil and vegetable oil were poured on the flooring and steps of four different stairwells inside Bartlett High School located at 701 W. Schick Road. At least one staff member and two students were injured as a result from falling on the slippery stairwell surfaces. Following an investigation, Bartlett Police cited the three 17-year-old male juveniles, Maggard, Davis, and Kostanzer for Dangerous Acts Prohibited.

The 17-year-old male juveniles, Maggard, Davis, and Konstanzer were released on their signatures and assigned a court date of June 8, 2010 at the Cook County court facility located in Rolling Meadows.
