Teens Cited After Going into Arts of Bartlett Tent After Hours

On June 28, 2010 Bartlett Police Department cited two 16-year-old male juveniles and a 15-year-old male juvenile for Curfew and Interference with a Village Officer.

On June 26, 2010 at approximately 3:30 am, Bartlett Police discovered three teens entered an Arts of Bartlett tent after hours that was set up for the 8th annual Bartlett Festival of the Arts in Downtown Bartlett. The three teens were located and apprehended a short time later after they fled on foot. Following an investigation, it was determined that nothing was damaged or stolen from the Arts of Bartlett tent that the teens entered.

The two 16-year-old male juveniles and the 15-year-old male juvenile were released to their parents after being assigned a court date of July 12, 2010 at the Cook County court facility located in Rolling Meadows.
