Elk Grove Resident Charged with Aggravated DUI

On Friday, August 27, 2010, Bartlett Police Department arrested Ivonne R. Trujillo, 31, of 991 Jefferson Square Apt. L, Elk Grove Village. The Cook County State's Attorney's Office and Bartlett Police charged her with a Class 4 Felony for Aggravated Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Class A Misdemeanors for Driving While License Suspended, Failure to Give Aid or Information, Leaving the Scene of an Accident, Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol with a BAC of .08 or more. She was also cited for Failure to Reduce Speed to Avoid an Accident and Operating an Uninsured Vehicle.

At approximately 12:00 am, Bartlett Police responded to the intersection of US Route 20/Lake Street and North Bartlett Road to investigate a hit & run motor vehicle crash involving two vehicles. Bartlett Police alleged a 32-year-old Hanover Park man was stopped at the intersection of US Route 20/Lake Street and North Bartlett Road in his blue colored 2006 Chevrolet vehicle when his vehicle was rear-ended by a gray colored 2000 Chevrolet vehicle driven by Trujillo. Bartlett Police also alleged Trujillo failed to give aid or information to the other driver and then left the scene eastbound on US Route 20/Lake Street. Bartlett Police took her into custody after locating her vehicle on US Route 20/Lake Street between Park Boulevard and North Avenue. Neither Trujillo nor the other driver were injured from the motor vehicle crash.

Trujillo was transported to the Cook County court facility located in Rolling Meadows for her bail bond hearing. She was issued a \$10,000 D bond (10% applies) with an assigned court date of September 15, 2010.
