Hanover Man Charged After Crashing Motorcycle into Mailbox

On March 19, 2010 the Bartlett Police Department arrested Anthony M. Kosinski, 24, of 1717 St. Ann Drive, Bartlett. He was charged with three Class A Misdemeanors for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, Failure to Give Information After Striking Unattended Vehicle, and No Valid Driver's License. He was also cited for Operating Uninsured Motor Vehicle, Failure to Reduce Speed to Avoid an Accident, Violation of Classification – Motorcycle, and Failure to Report Accident to Police Authority.

At approximately 11:45 am, Bartlett Police responded to the 300 block of E. Country Drive to investigate a single-vehicle crash involving a motorcycle. Bartlett Police alleged Kosinski was driving a black colored 2006 motorcycle westbound on E. Country Drive when he lost control and struck a mailbox. Kosinski then fled the scene on foot and was later apprehended without incident in the 240 block of Mc Cook Court. Kosinski suffered minor injuries and was transported to St. Alexius Hospital by the Bartlett Fire Protection District.

Kosinski was released on a \$3,000 Individual Bond after he was discharged from the hospital. He will be assigned a future court date at the DuPage County court facility located in Wheaton by the Circuit Court Clerk.
