Two Juveniles Charged After Store Employee is Sprayed with Pepper Spray

On March 27, 2010 the Bartlett Police Department arrested a 16-year-old female with a Class A Misdemeanor for Retail Theft and a 12-year-old male with a Class A Misdemeanor for Battery.

At approximately 11:00 pm, Bartlett Police Department responded to a convenience store in the 100 block of E. Lake Street to investigate a retail theft and a battery report. A store clerk alleged a 16-year-old female stole approximately \$12.00 worth of candy from the store and then a 12-year-old male used pepper spray on him before they fled the scene on foot. Bartlett Police located them in the 200 block of N. Elroy Avenue and they were taken into custody.

The 16-year-old female and the 12-year-old male were both petitioned to Cook County Juvenile Court and later released to their parents.
