- Pet medications
- Vitamins and supplements

RED IS NO

- * Needles and sharp objects
- * Syringes with needles
- * Thermometers/Personal Care
- * Controlled substances

Any drug as defined in the five categories of the Federal Controlled Substances Act of 1970. These medications are categorized by "schedules" based on their potential for abuse or addiction. They range from Schedule 1, or C1 (illegal drugs) to C2 to C5 which indicates a decrease in potential for abuse or addiction. The schedules cover opium (and other opiates), hallucinogens, as well as prescriptions containing narcotics or amphetamines.
